

### Electro/Mechanical Industrial Assembler

This role is for an enthusiastic and capable Industrial Assembler to work in a small technology group as part of a dynamic and expanding company in the Oil & Gas Industry. You will be working in a new medium volume manufacturing cell for the assembly and test of parts, and components for integration into larger assemblies. You will contribute to the operation of a manufacturing cell which has medium and high volume requirements; this being the preparation of small components (high volume) and subassemblies for integration into larger assemblies (medium volume). The role involves the creation of subassemblies and flowing through further medium volume production processes. Two of the workstations involve the use of laser welding system, in the use of which, you will be trained by our Laser Safety Officer.

#### Principal Duties:

- Operate in a production cell to build high and medium volume subassemblies
- Set up and use manufacturing jigs to aid the manufacturing processes
- Able to perform a variety of tasks
- Operate a "right first time/every time" production strategy
- Operate either of two laser welders (subject to completion of training)
- Carry out subassembly tests; simple electrical and mechanical

#### Required Knowledge & Experience:

- Methodology required to handle/manipulate small components in high volume in an engineering environment
- Ability to interpret technical drawings
- Ability to follow documented processes and follow verbal instructions
- Experience within an electronic/mechanical manufacturing environment
- Attention to detail and working within a team to produce quality of workmanship in the timescales required
- Team player with good written, verbal and interpersonal communication skills
- Collating and presenting production data
- Interaction with various internal personnel, ensuring adherence to delivery schedules

- Ability to maintain and establish effective working relationships
- Proficiency with standard computer applications
- Ability to perform assigned responsibilities with minimal to moderate supervision, adhering to deadlines and commitments
